Bramley Moor Lane Public Enquiry Commences Tuesday 19th June 2018

The beginning of the public enquiry for test drilling at Bramley Moor Lane is getting ever close. Eckington Against Fracking are working tirelessly to present their case with the help of speakers from CADAF and Dronfield Town Council. Lee Rowley MP, Angelique Foster (leader of Dronfield Town Council), Alex Dale, Anthony Hutchinson, former MP Harry Barnes and several others will all be speaking at the enquiry on subjects including road infrastructure, traffic, former coal workings and cumulative impact. Anyone who wishes to have a say is entitled to do so provided it is not a repeat of someone else's speech. The enquiry will focus on planning matters and EAF are preparing their case along these lines. This is your town and will change forever if Ineos overturn the planners recommendations. Now is the time to step up and do your bit for our town and its future.
